

Greek Armed Forces covid vaccination ratio and comparison to general population

Summary: The covid vaccination program has various level of acceptance between nations and sub groups of people. The scope of this presentation is to examine the level of acceptance of the greek army, navy and air force population.

Methods/results: Based on the data from the National Defence General Staff of Greece, we compared the data of the different branches of the greek armed forces (army, navy, air force, common corps) with the general population. A further analysis was made for permanent military personnel, permanent civilian personnel and conscript soldiers.

Conclusions: A total of 60.88% (army), 73.11% (navy), 70.24% (air force), 82.33% (common corps) had at least two doses of the vaccine (or 1-dose of single-dose vaccine), compared to 73.2% of the general population. However, only 30.87% (army), 43.28 (navy), compared to 54% of general population had the booster.
